

Secretary's Report for the AGM 2024

Financially we have grown very well although we must maintain the BBQ fund raisers and the Beach Ramps each year as these bring in much needed dollars to keep the station running. Focusing on grants will also help us financially.

Our Policies and Procedures have been reviewed but as yet need to be formalised and accepted by the board. We need to maintain good governance.

Volunteers have again been low this year and it is a struggle to engage people into helping. Even with local groups that have volunteers to help either in the building or the garden do not seem to stay long enough and this can be for many and varied reasons. So the garden and the housekeeping is always left to the same few people.

The board this year has been well accepted and has maintained a steady pace with very little angst amongst board members as had been previously, so hopefully that will continue going forward.

Membership could be stronger as we have not seen a lot of new members join unless they were training to be a presenter. The revised Constitution has been finalised and will be voted on at an SGM along with the AGM as to whether it will be accepted or not.

Members have commented that they were pleased to see the minutes come out within the time frame of a few weeks and not months as had been the case, so let's hope it continues that way!

Tribe FM needs to continue to grow and gain respect in the community and it can only do this with the efforts of everyone working together as a "Tribe" and not just for themselves.

I would firstly like to sincerely thank Jennifer Hendriks for her time as Chairperson at Tribe FM. Since becoming Chairperson, Jennifer has obtained grant money in excess of \$35,000 for Tribe FM. The result is that Tribe FM now has a bank balance that is the best I have seen since joining the board in 2018.

The board has seen a lot of comings and goings since the last AGM. To everyone involved, thank you for your contributions and efforts. I feel the board has set a very high standard, and hope that the new board will continue the good work. Since taking on the role of Chairperson earlier this year, I have been impressed by the amount of assistance I have received from the other board members. When everybody works together, the job is so much easier.

Finally, thank you to everyone who has contributed to your community station Tribe FM, and I look forward to another successful year ahead.
